<u>Mother Goose</u>	<u>Read with Me</u>
This program is a parent child interactive program that will provide you with a variety of songs, stories and rhymes while you engage with your baby.	This is an early literacy that introduces babies and their families to the world of books. Join us for this fun session where we will read stories, share songs and make baby a homemade book. (Birth -12 months)
Focus on Toddlers	<u>Make and Take</u>
This interactive program enhances and promotes healthy child development by providing age specific activities focusing on social, intellectual, physical, and emotional skills. Each week, parents/caregivers and their toddlers will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities and crafts based on holiday themes.	This is an interactive parent and child program. Your child will have the opportunity to create a variety of books and games. * Registration Required
<u>Infant Massage</u>	Play to Learn
This program provides the opportunity to learn the benefits of massage as well as relaxation techniques to use with your infant. This session is taught by a certified infant massage instructor. *Registration Required*	Play to Learn is a drop-in program designed to encourage quality interactions between adults and children. This program is open to children birth to six years and their caregivers to play and learn together. Family Time occurs during Play to Learn where children over the age of seven can accompany a sibling aged birth to six years.
