<p><u>Mother Goose</u></p> <p>This program is a parent child interactive program that will provide you with a variety of songs, stories and rhymes while you engage with your baby.</p>	<p><u>Infant Massage</u></p> <p>This program provides the opportunity to learn the benefits of massage as well as relaxation techniques to use with your infant. This session is taught by a certified infant massage instructor. *Registration Required**</p>
<p><u>Focus on Preschool</u></p> <p>This school readiness program will allow your child to develop skills that will help them be successful when they enter kindergarten. While participating in the program, your child will have the opportunity to enhance social, fine motor, language, mathematical, problem solving and self-help skills.</p>	<p>Play to Learn</p> <p>Play to Learn is a drop-in program designed to encourage quality interactions between adults and children. This program is open to children birth to six years and their caregivers to play and learn together. Family Time occurs during Play to Learn where children over the age of seven can accompany a sibling aged birth to six years</p>
