## Program Descriptions

<p><b><u>Focus on Infants</u></b></p> <p>Focus on Infants is a program designed for infant parents to join together in a relaxed atmosphere to discuss infant and parent related topics each week. Guest speakers/specialized programming will be provided to extend the interests of the participants.</p>	<p><b><u>Focus on Toddlers</u></b></p> <p>This interactive program enhances and promotes healthy child development by providing age specific activities focusing on social, intellectual, physical, and emotional skills. Each week, parents/caregivers and their toddlers will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities (i.e. creative, sensory, tactile, gross/fine motor, music and movement, etc.)</p>
<p><b><u>Baby Circle Time</u></b></p> <p>This program is a musical experience for parents/caregivers and their child(ren). Engage with your child while participating in a variety of musical experiences. Activities may include: age-appropriate instruments, finger play songs, circle songs, parachute play, bubble experiences, etc.</p>	<p><b><u>Focus on Preschool</u></b></p> <p>This school readiness program will allow your child to develop skills that will help them be successful when they enter Kindergarten. While participating in the program, your child will have the opportunity to enhance social, fine motor, language, mathematical, problem solving and self-help skills.</p>
<p><b><u>Family Gym</u></b></p> <p>Activities such as balls, hoops, tunnels, tents, bean bags and music are available to enhance large muscle development.</p>	<p><b><u>Family Music and Movement</u></b></p> <p>This program allows participants to explore the joy of music through interactive, musical based activities. Parachute games, instruments and props are used as we learn new songs and rhymes together.</p>
<p><b><u>Special Connections</u></b></p> <p>This program provides a safe and interactive place to come and play for children who need extra support and their parents/caregivers. Families will have the opportunity to connect with each other as well as community agencies. Older siblings are welcome.</p>	<p><b><u>Infant Massage</u></b></p> <p>This program provides the opportunity to learn the benefits of massage and relaxation techniques to use with your infant. This program is taught by a certified infant massage instructor.</p>
<p><b><u>Play to Learn</u></b></p> <p>Play to Learn is a drop-in program designed to encourage quality interactions between adults and children. This program is open to children birth to six years and their caregivers to play and learn together. Family Time occurs during Play to Learn where children over the age of seven can accompany a sibling aged birth to six years.</p>
