Program Descriptions

Active supervision is an expectation of parents/caregivers during all programs.

<p>Baby Circle Time</p> <p>This program is a musical experience for parents/caregivers and their child(ren). Engage with your child while participating in a variety of musical experiences. Activities may include: age-appropriate instruments, finger play songs, circle songs, parachute play, bubble experiences, etc.</p>	<p>Parent and Child Mother Goose</p> <p>A group experience for parents/caregivers and their infants to enjoy songs and rhymes based on the tradition of oral storytelling. This program provides consistent and enjoyable language experiences that strengthen the parent-child bond and build a supportive network for parents. *this is an 9 week program*</p>
<p>Focus on Toddlers</p> <p>This interactive program enhances and promotes healthy child development by providing age specific activities focusing on social, intellectual, physical, and emotional skills. Each week, parents/caregivers and their toddlers will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities (i.e. creative, sensory, tactile, gross/fine motor, music and movement, etc.)</p>	<p>Focus on Infants</p> <p>Focus on Infants is a program designed for infant parents to join together in a relaxed atmosphere to discuss infant and parent related topics each week. Guest speakers/specialized programming will be provided to extend the interests of the participants.</p>
<p>Infant Massage</p> <p>This program provides the opportunity to learn the benefits of massage and relaxation techniques to use with your infant. This program is taught by a certified infant massage instructor.</p>	<p>Family Gym</p> <p>Activities such as balls, hoops, tunnels, tents, bean bags and music are available to enhance large muscle development.</p>
<p>Dad and Me</p> <p>Enjoy a special night out with Dad, Grandpa, Uncle, Brother, etc. Participants will have the opportunity to enjoy a yummy dinner, along with activities, songs and stories.</p>	<p>Family Music and Movement</p> <p>This program allows participants to explore the joy of music through interactive, musical based activities. Parachute games, instruments and props are used as we learn new songs and rhymes together.</p>
<p>Focus on Preschool</p> <p>This school readiness program will allow your child to develop skills that will help them be successful when they enter Kindergarten. While participating in the program, your child will have the opportunity to enhance social, fine motor, language, mathematical, problem solving and self-help skills.</p>	<p>Play to Learn</p> <p>Play to Learn is a drop-in program designed to encourage quality interactions between adults and children. This program is open to children birth to six years and their caregivers to play and learn together. Family Time occurs during Play to Learn where children over the age of seven can accompany a sibling aged birth to six years.</p>
<p>Sensory Fun</p> <p>Engage all the senses with this fun, interactive program. Children will participate in a variety of sensory activities including playdough, messy play, crafts and much more!</p>	<p>Snack Attack</p> <p>Want to learn some creative and delicious snacks to make with your child? This program will have a new snack each week along with activities that relate to your yummy creation.</p>
